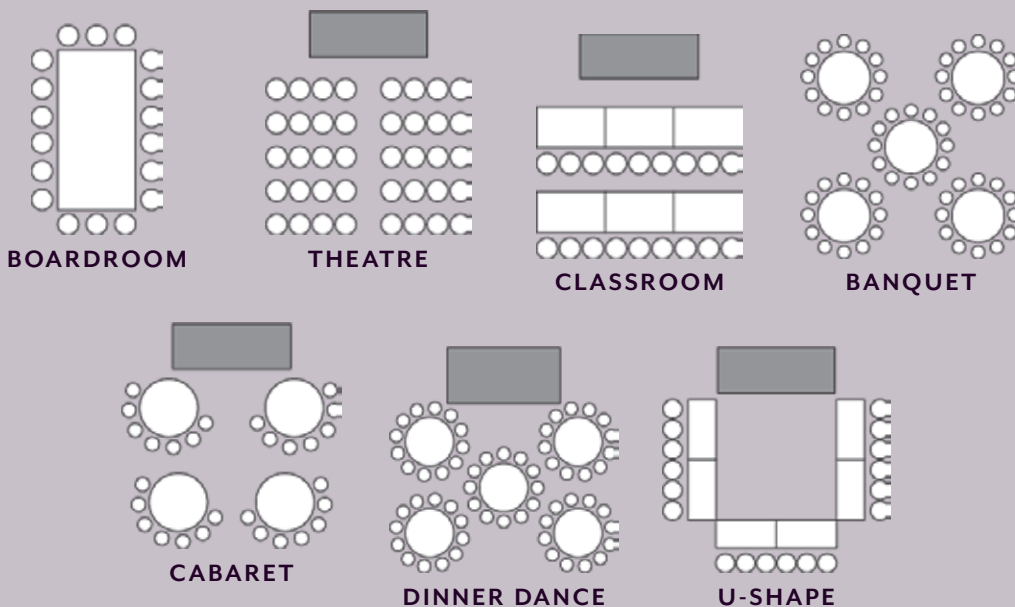

## Seating Styles



### BOARDROOM

Seats arranged around a central table. Boardroom style seating is ideal for smaller discussion-focused groups, and may be less suited to speakers or visual presentations.

### THEATRE

Seats arranged in rows facing a stage, head table, or speaker. Most effective for audio-visual presentations or for large groups where reading or writing is not required.

### CLASSROOM

Seats arranged behind tables in rows facing a stage, head table, or speaker. Most effective for audio-visual presentations like training sessions, conferences, or product launches.

### BANQUET

Also known as Cruise-style seating. 10-12 seats arranged around circular tables with all guests facing inwards. Ideal for large group events like Christmas parties, weddings and award nights.

### CABARET

Seats are placed in an arc around circular tables with seats facing forwards towards a stage or speaker. Commonly used where the guests need to see a speaker or performer.

### U-SHAPED

Tables are positioned in a 'U' or horseshoe shape with seats facing towards a stage or speaker. Well suited for training sessions and presentations.

### DINNER DANCE

Banquet/Cruise style seating with with a dedicated space for a dancefloor. Commonly used for events where a DJ or live music will encourage guests to get up and dance.
